We would like to thank all of you who have supported our boys and the program over the years. We appreciate your interest and confidence in what we are doing in the lives of the boys who are placed with us.

As a non-profit group home there are times when we have challenges in our operations. Now is one of those times. Based on new federal and state agency guidelines, we are having to adjust the program to meet the demands of the care needed for the boys made available to us. As many of you are aware, the level of care in the past for Mountain Top was more of minimum oversight for the boys in our program along with education through the Walker County School System. Based on the changes in the agency guidelines, most of the boys available for residential group homes now are in a much higher or maximum level of care. The boys will be more difficult and require additional staff to deal with serious behavioral issues.

As we have seen in other programs we have reviewed as we struggle to meet these changes, this level of care will necessitate the need for on campus education including home school type instruction and GED certification. Additionally, there will need to be some construction and structural changes to our facilities for classrooms and to bedrooms and bathrooms.
